

©Silkspike Dolls - Pattern #RK-103 - Riley A-Line Dress

This is a free pattern - feel free to share the link to my website, but this pattern was not intended for distribution or resale.

Seam allowances are 1/4" as indicated on the pattern. You should be able to sew with the right side of your presser foot along the outside edge of the fabric.

You will need two small pieces of fabric - one will be your main, and the other, your lining. Match the vertical center marking with the straight grain of the fabric. The back of the dress will end up on the bias, so this dress may not work with strong prints or checks.

METHOD:

Cut out your pattern.
Lay your lining fabric on the table face up.
Lay your main fabric on top of the lining, face down.
Your two fabrics are now right sides together.
Lay your pattern on both layers of fabric and pin in place. Cut out both layers carefully.

Cut two straps 2-1/2" long from ribbon or decorative trim. Do not use ribbon that is wider than 1/4"

You will need two small sets of snap fasteners.

Be sure to measure your test square after printing this pattern. It should measure 1 inch square (2.5cm)

This pattern was designed to be printed at A-4, but if your paper is 8-1/2 x 11, you may get a better result if you set your printer at LETTER size.

Set your printer at Custom Scale 100%
